MOUNT WASHINGTON RESORT TO BE FEATURED IN EPISODE OF POPULAR TELEVISION SERIES *GHOST HUNTERS* ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 16th, 2008

BRETTON WOODS, NH, April 11, 2008 – With a history spanning over 100 years, and the countless tales that have unfolded throughout its vast interior of guest rooms, corridors, and ballrooms, it was only a matter of time before The Mount Washington Hotel became a hunting ground for “TAPS”, i.e. The Atlantic Paranormal Society. TAPS is a group of paranormal investigators who travel across the country to sites that have ghost stories surrounding them. Their exploits are filmed and have become the popular Sci-Fi TV Channel series *Ghost Hunters*, currently

in its fourth season. The next *Ghost Hunters* episode, entitled “Ghostly Conversations”, features The Mount Washington Hotel, and is scheduled to air Wednesday, April 16th, 2008, at 9:00 pm and 11:00 pm (Eastern time).

Ghost Hunters, including lead TAPS investigators Grant Wilson and Jason Hawes, visited The Mount Washington Hotel in February, and set up their state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment to conduct their investigation of so-called paranormal activity. First and foremost, TAPS aims to debunk the most sensational stories and find scientific explanations, however it is their mission to proceed with a detailed investigation in search of the truth. Fred Hollis, who has been in charge of security at The Mount Washington Hotel for nearly twenty years, provided an “insider tour” of The Hotel to Ghost Hunters investigators and granted overnight access to certain areas of The Hotel for the purpose of the investigation. Hollis appears in the episode and the results of the investigation are reported to him.
